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Mentoring Process: How It Works

- Commanding General Endorses Mentoring Program
- Garrison Commander & CSM Approves Mentoring Program
- CSM (Garrison Side) Identifies Mentees along with ESO
 - Soldier and Email Approval
 - Coordinates with EMD Mentoring Liaison
- EMD Mentoring Liaison & CSM/ESO Link Mentor to Mentee
- Mentoring Liaison--Las Cruces Civic Leaders Establish Mentor Pool

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Mentoring and Rules of Engagement

- A Humanitarian Effort – No Personal Agendas
- Support Soldier's Educational Goals and Aspirations
- No Academic Counseling – Soldier will have a SA with a College
- Encourage Soldier to see their Guidance Counselor at Ed Center
- Assist in Identifying Academic, Social and Community Resources

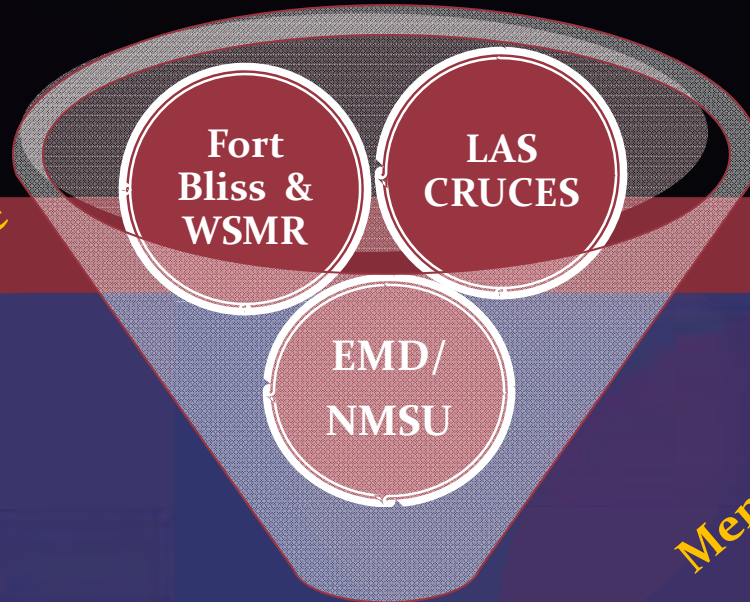

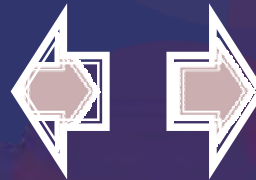
